The entrance gate is opposite the turnstiles for Musselburgh Racecourse. Do not use the school's main postcode as that will take you to a different

- There are 3 steps into the grounds of the school. Alternatively, we can arrange for you to enter through a different gate with level access and car drop off at the door.
- · Ramped entrance to the theatre itself, with spaces for wheelchairs at the front of the auditorium
- · A level access toilet is adjacent to the theatre.
